





Sacraments

INFANT BAPTISM

Parents wishing to have their children (birth to age 6) baptized should be registered in either parish and complete an online class. Godparents are required to provide paperwork prior to the sacrament.

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

For children who have been baptized as Catholics, First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion preparation begins in the first grade and culminates with the reception of the Sacrament, following Easter, in the second grade. Children are prepared by their religion teachers, either through our Catholic schools or our parish religious education program (FLOCK). Additional meetings and activities for the children and their parents occur outside of classroom instruction, including the Jesus Day retreat.

CONFIRMATION

The Sacrament of Confirmation is offered every year to students in the seventh grade, with formative activities beginning a calendar year before the sacrament. We do provide catechesis in school and in FLOCK, in addition to community service, a retreat experience, and other faith enrichment activities.

RECONCILIATION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available on Saturday afternoons before Mass or by appointment. There are Parish Communal Reconciliation Services with individual confessions, typically scheduled during Advent and Lent each year.

MARRIAGE

Couples planning to celebrate the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony should contact either parish office at least a year before they plan to wed. Ordinarily the couple (or one party) must be registered, participating parishioners for at least six months. After this six month period, the couple can begin making arrangements.

HOLY ORDERS

Explore the possibility of a vocation to the Ordained Priesthood, Diaconate or Vowed Religious Life for Women and Men.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

This is primarily a sacrament of spiritual strengthening and sometimes physical healing. The sacrament is administered to those facing serious surgery or illness. Elderly people may be anointed if they become notably weakened.

BECOMING CATHOLIC (O.C.I.A.)

O.C.I.A. - the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults* - is the Catholic Church's process for forming and welcoming new members, supporting those who are returning to the Church, and helping those who are life-long Catholics to appreciate their faith more deeply. Weekly sessions provide an opportunity for participants to understand the teachings and traditions of Catholicism, and to discern what God is calling them to in their spiritual journey.

SAFEPARISH (AS/SVF)

Liturgical Ministries

ART & ENVIRONMENT (SVF)

Ensures that our church is appropriately decorated for the liturgical season. The aim is to draw the congregation into worship and to remind us of the facets of Christ's life, death and resurrection, depending on what is being celebrated at the time.

BAPTISMAL MINISTRY (AS)

Parishioner volunteers assist families and clergy during Baptism ceremonies.

Offers comfort to mourners by assisting and planning the Funeral Liturgy and Mass, in partnership with the respective funeral home. They then lead the services the day-of and provide assistance as needed.

EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION and EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS (AS) (SVF)

HOSPITALITY/USHERS/GREETERS (AS) (SVF)

Behind the scenes organizers. They assist members of the assembly in finding seating, answering questions, taking up the collection, obtaining headphones for the hearing impaired, and inviting members of the assembly to bring up the offertory gifts.

LECTORS (AS) (SVF)

Lectors are called to proclaim the scripture at daily, Holy Day, and weekend liturgies. They carefully review the Scripture passages and practice reading them before Mass.

MUSIC MINISTRY (AS) (SVF)

By joining our hearts with the beauty of sound, this ministry gives melody to our faith through the power of music. The Music Ministry has opportunities for vocalists, cantors, and instrumentalists of all ages. Our role is to enhance all liturgical celebrations by encouraging and modeling full participation as part of the worshipping assembly. SACRISTANS (AS) (SVF)

MISSIONARY FAMILIES OF CHRIST (MFC) (AS)

MFC is dedicated to evangelization in order to strengthen the family and to stand in defense of the culture of life. MFC believes that Christian family renewal can best be achieved by inviting Jesus to be the Lord of our homes by allowing the power of the Holy Spirit to lead our family lives through the full use of all spiritual gifts at our disposal. Parish Councils & Committees

BUILDINGS & GROUNDS COMMITTEE (AS)

Maintains and supervises the maintenance and improvement of our facilities and campus.

BUILDING & FINANCE COUNCIL (SVF)

Members are appointed by the Pastor to advise and assist with Parish budget, management, and maintenance of Parish properties. Also provides guidance with other financial affairs essential to the Parish.

FINANCE COUNCIL (AS)

Assists the Pastor and Director of Finance in accounting for revenue and expenditures, prepares the annual budget, monitors the financial condition of the Parish, and makes recommendations to the Pastor. Finance Commission meets on a monthly basis, with a few exceptions around holidays.

PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL (SVF)

Council members are elected for a three-year term, advising and supporting the Pastor and Parish staff regarding essential activities, affairs, and ministries.

SOCIAL OUTREACH COMMITTEE (AS/SVF)

Coordinates parish outreach programs and service to the community, as well as promoting an awareness of broader social issues. Outreach programs include Habitat for Humanity, Found House, Northeast Emergency Distribution Service, Thanksgiving collections, Easter Baskets, Walnut Hills Soup Kitchen, and Service Blitz Days.
