Dear St. Vincent Ferrer Parishioners: As you can see from the Annual Financial Report on the other side of this letter, in the last 2 years, St. Vincent Ferrer Parish suffered a loss of \$316,000.

Several reasons stand out for this loss. Since 2007, our annual Sunday collection has declined by over \$150,000. In the last two years, school enrollment has declined, and major parish fundraising income has declined. **Our parish cannot continue to sustain such losses.** Your SVF Building & Finance Commission has called for an all-out, total parish effort to revitalize every level of parish finances. How do we respond?

SVF School has formed a pro-active Marketing Committee, chaired by our new Principal, Mark Henderson, to rebuild school enrollment. You might be interested to know that Archdiocesan staff took a look at our school and gave us an "A" for having a very sound financial structure, and another "A" for having an excellent academic program. These facts and our outstanding reputation give the new Marketing Committee a good head start.

New Festival leadership has decided it is time to reinvent our Festival. Starting with moving our Festival to September for 2014, every aspect of this event is being reworked. Look for more exciting changes, and a new SVF Festival web site, in the coming months.

Fund-raising remains a challenge we must meet as a parish. The heart of parish financial support is our Sunday collection. Without a strong Sunday collection, our parish cannot maintain its ministries. You, our parish families, have a history of generous parish support. In recent years you fully funded a new air-conditioner at church (\$65,000), a new parish truck and snow plow (\$35,000), and a new roof on the Parish Center (\$85,000). And yet, our Sunday collection has dropped steadily since 2007.

I do not want to solve this problem by making deep cuts in parish life. Rather, I pray we can grow as a parish family in our support for St. Vincent Ferrer Parish and all that it offers. In the coming weeks you will hear and read more about how we can work together as a faith community to improve our financial outlook. I hope you will all read the October issue of our parish newsletter, *Living Church*, where there will be more information.

Thank you to everyone who makes St. Vincent Ferrer Parish a wonderful place to worship and grow in faith. May God bless us as we look to the future together.
