In a small way we've been doing our part for over 27 years; providing the main course for Thanksgiving and Christmas dinners at **Our Daily Bread** Soup Kitchen. **HELP Feed the Needy!** "How"? After cooking a holiday turkey, please use the following instructions:

- Cut all meat off the bones
- **BOTH white and dark meat are welcome.** Place all meat together and freeze
- A less "fuss" option might be to cook 2 or more Turkey Breasts, slice and freeze

How/where to drop off turkeys (3 options):

SVF church office:

Cooked/Frozen Turkey can be dropped off at the St Vincent Parish Office, M – F, during normal business hours... (*Please do not leave food outside or in hallways.*)

SVF Jaspers Room Kitchen:

Specific instructions for the holidays:

- ▶ Place in the SVF Church Jaspers Room kitchenette "frig" freezer T F, 8a to 9:15a OR Sat -Sun (before/after Mass times) NOTE: this is not a large freezer
- ***Christmas ONLY! Cooked HAM(s). Any brand of Honey or Sugar glazed sliced ham is welcome

Drop-off days for Thanksgiving: Sundays, November 17 and 24, 8:15am to 11:45am –

Kitchen entrance, SVF / Hamilton Hall- **look for banner in main school parking lot**. (stay tuned for drop-off days for Christmas turkeys and ham – TBD)

If you'd rather donate a check (or cash) there are 2 options:

- 1.) place in either Sunday church collection marked "Turkeys" OR
- 2.) write a check payable to St. Vincent Ferrer with memo line: "Turkeys".
